## What's In Your Water?



**Lead and Arsenic:** Detected in more than 20% of US tap water, lead is a neurotoxin and very harmful to children, impacting brain development and behavior. Perhaps the most potent carcinogen in US tap water, arsenic is detected in 10% of all samples.



**Nickel:** Many people have skin and throat allergies when they ingest nickel in elevated levels. Not EPA-regulated, nickel is often detected if a home has nickel-plated fixtures.



**Coliform and E. Coli Bacteria:** If your water comes from a local utility, bacterial contamination is uncommon. However, private well water should be tested for bacterial pathogens.



**Nitrates and Hardness:** Nitrates and nitrites may indicate possible contamination from nearby agricultural runoff. It is particularly a risk in rural and suburban areas. Hard water clogs and breaks your plumbing, leaves film on glassware, prohibits soap from lathering and can taste chalky.
